- Saturday Academy: Campus and Community Students are showing up for Saturday Academy.
 As of Saturday, February 10, 2018, we have 8 students attending Saturday Academy. We also have several Columbus Career and College Academy Ambassadors and Beta Club students who volunteer to assist our students.
- Partnership with SCC: We have 9 of our 15 seniors enrolled at Southeastern either in traditional college courses or Workforce Continuing Education (Job certification within 5 weeks of starting program). For example, welding, CNA1, Certified Production Technician (CPT).
- Occupational Rehabilitation: A Partnership has been formed with Mr. Gleenwood Davis (Counselor for Occupational Rehabilitation), this program assist our Special Education, OCS, students with finding work in the community. Mr. Davis also offers our students Educational and IQ testing free of charge.
- Technology Grant: We have purchased 12 laptops for middle school a charge cart and head phones.
- Sports Grant: Basketballs, Ropes, Stacks were purchased for Gym use.
- Implementation of INGINTA: IGINITA Software program that is DPI approved that offer high school courses, so that students that are behind in high school credits can work in that program for credit recovery and to gain credits toward graduation.

- 9 of our graduating students are more than half-way through their courses both online and seated (and doing well)
- There are 13 students who have completed a high school course on IGNITIA in addition to their seated classes. This will bring them near or at grade level.
- Two of our seniors have been accepted into four-year colleges and are applying for scholarships.
- ACT testing is complete. The scores are in. The sores were not as high as we would like, but
 the students showed a desire to work hard on this test and took all the time provided for
 them. For this we are very proud.
- We have enrolled 12 new students from BGH.
- Dr. Simmons and Dr. Bradshaw attended a recruitment night at Columbus Charter School in Whiteville. Several parents have shown an interest in attending Thomas Academy and have had parents do a campus tour.
- Thomas Academy has received grant money to: a. furnish document cameras for each teacher this should help reduce the amount of copies teachers use. b. buy laptops and a charge cart which will allow for computers to travel from classroom to classroom on a check-out basis, c. \$10000 for an after school tutoring program. We are choosing students who show the most need using MAPS data and EVAAS data, .Our concentration is on Middle School Mathematics as this is our lowest scoring test area. This grant is from DPI (PRC-116).



Dr. Bradshaw wrote this grant proposal. We are targeted to start Monday, April 16. **d.** Another grant written by Dr. Bradshaw was approved. It will help pay for substitute teachers when our teachers go to workshops and conferences.

- The 17-minute walk-out that was conducted in other schools to rember the lives lost in the
 recent Florida school shooting was modified by Thomas Academy. Thomas Academy, under
 the leadership of Pastor Joe, conducted a service in our gym to the student body. Each name
 was called, a brief inspiration was given about each, a candle was lit in their honor, and
 they received a 17 second moment of silence. The students were very respectful.
- Staff meetings were held to fine-tune our lock-down procedure in the case of an emergency.
 Needs were assessed and a short practice was conducted with staff during a workday. Dr.
 Bradshaw also had the Lake Waccamaw Police Department come over and discuss procedures with her.

Questions concerning the Thomas Academy update: Dave Wyatt: Is Columbus Christian Academy through the 8th grade only? Dr. Bradshaw: yes

Dave Wyatt: Board is glad to hear that Dr. Bradshaw involved the Lake Waccamaw Police Department in the planning of Lock Down Procedures. Dr. Bradshaw: Police also advised that students who may be in the parking lot or between classes outside of school to disperse, not group together. The plan is to practice once a month.
